

DAILY PROCEDURES

- 1. Clean/vacuum entrance matting.
- 2. Dust mop hallways and classrooms to remove loose dirt and soils.
- 3. Wet mop/auto scrub hallways with neutral cleaner.
- 4. Spot mop classrooms with neutral cleaner.

WEEKLY PROCEDURES

- 1. Inspect and clean or change entrance matting.
- 2. Dust mop hallways and classrooms to remove loose dirt and soils.
- 3. Use long handled scraper to remove gum and sticky soils.
- 4. Wet mop/auto scrub hallways and entrances with neutral cleaner.
- 5. Inspect high traffic floors for wear. Burnish/spray buff high areas that show signs of wear.

MONTHLY PROCEDURES

- 1. Inspect and clean or change entrance matting.
- 2. Dust mop hallways and classrooms to remove loose dirt and soils.
- 3. Use long handle scraper to remove gum and sticky soils.
- 4. Wet mop/auto scrub hallways and entrances with neutral cleaner.
- 5. Inspect high traffic floors for wear. Burnish/spray buff high areas that show signs of wear.
- 6. If needed, apply a coat of floor restorer and buff/burnish to restore protective layer and appearance.
- 7. If areas are heavily worn, scrub with neutral cleaner and apply a light coat of finish.

- **SAFE CLEANING TIPS** 1. Always use "Caution Wet Floor" signs to mark your work area.
 - 2. Inspect electric cords for signs of wear before using.
 - 3. Use clean mops, and change mop water frequently.
